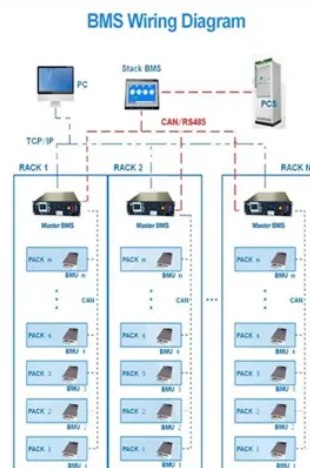

The charge current must be selected according to the size of the battery. If you are charging a 12-volt battery with six cells to a limit of 2.4 volts, the voltage must be 14.40 volts which is six times 2.4 volts. This is about 10-30 percent of the rated capacity.
