

Capacitor makes a sound



Overview

In short it's a high pitched squeal/whine/hiss/buzz noise emanating from a computer or electronic device. It can often be located towards a specific component such as a power supply or graphics card and the noise often changes volume and pitch especially when a certain task is carried out on a PC such as a. Common sense prevails here. You need to look and listen to locate the noise but it's not always an easy task as the culprit maybe difficult to get to or covered by a cooler. What you are looking for is usually a capacitor or inductor/power coil. Capacitors haven't. Capacitor squeal will almost certainly result in a failure if it already hasn't. It will be RMA time for this component. Coil whine is a different story but cannot always be solved, after all the acoustic noise is a by-product of something working normally; 1 - Leave it. There are actually 2 causes; Capacitor Squeal is actually the noise heard when a capacitor is about to fail. Essentially it's where gas is escaping.

Capacitors in loudspeakers explained -

Capacitor values are given in farad (F), usually in microfarad (μF) and volts (V). The farad value indicates what is known as a capacitor's capacitance rating, or simply capacitance, which tells us how much energy a capacitor contains at a given voltage. A capacitor with a 1 farad capacity, can be charged with 1 volt.

What do bad caps sound like?

When a capacitor drifts off of its regular value and goes out of spec, this changes the crossover point and as such, this makes the speaker sound different than intended. The result largely depends on the speaker design itself and the complexity of the crossover, some will sound drastically worse than others and worse in different ways than other speakers.

What electronic component of a computer produces (sound) noise?

Yes, components can produce noise. Common noise producers are coils and capacitors. Magnetostriction for coils (i.e. inductors/transformers) and Piezoelectricity for (ceramic) capacitors are the reasons. These effects cause the component to change shape ever so slightly, and if the applied frequency is in the audio range we can hear it as a buzz.
