

Ghana first solar



Overview

The Yendi Solar PV project, located on about 140 acres of land, will be the first fully Ghanaian owned utility scale solar installation in the country and the second largest solar project after the 55MW Bui Solar plant. Ghana's renewable energy capacity stands at 280MW, roughly 5 percent of the national energy mix. LMI Holdings is developing a 1,000MW solar park at Dawa Industrial Enclave targeting completion by 2030. Wholly Ghanaian owned company, First Sky Group has announced it will complete a 50-megawatt utility-scale solar power plant in Ghana's Northern region by the end of March 2026, marking one of the most significant Ghanaian-owned investments in renewable energy infrastructure to date.
