

Lilongwe renewable electricity



Overview

Malawi's capital is now home to a 48MW photovoltaic array paired with 32MWh battery storage – the country's first grid-scale hybrid energy solution. Think of it as a power bank for the city, storing sunshine during the day and releasing it when households need it most. Lilongwe, Malawi | 25th November 2024 — The Global Energy Alliance for People and Planet (GEAPP) and the Government of Malawi have officially launched the construction of a 20 MW battery energy storage system (BESS) at the Kanengo substation in Malawi's capital city, Lilongwe. This is GEAPP's first. In 2022, Malawi's power system faced a major crisis. Malawi was bringing more solar power onto the grid but.
