The Australian Capital Territory (ACT) is making significant strides in its renewable energy journey by advancing innovative energy solutions like microgrids and community batteries. In collaboration with Evoenergy, the ACT government is rolling out the second phase of its community-scale battery. On 25 August 2023, we announced the Regional Microgrids Program of up to \$125 million to develop and deploy microgrids across regional Australia. This evolving microgrid and community battery revolution is creating unprecedented energy independence and.
