

Solar panel no-load voltage drops



Overview

Battery voltage drop

Voltage Sag is when you measure the voltage of the battery before you connect the load say 12.6 volts, and you turn on the load and the battery voltage drops immediately to say 12.4 volts or less. If you were to fully charge your battery on solar, then did not run anything all night, the next morning you will read 12.6 volts or fully charged.

Battery bank drops drastically to 12.4 volts!!!

Hi, I'm experiencing a drastic drop in voltage when the sun sets from 13.7V (float) to 12.4V with less than 200 watts load (lights & TV set) My setup is a simple 12V system (will upgrade to 24V, waiting for 24V inverter).

PV Panel output voltage

Panel temperature will affect voltage – as has been discussed in another blog. Have a look at these I-V (Current vs Voltage) and P-V (Power vs Voltage) charts for a 305W solar panel from Trina Solar. You can see in the P-V curve that as the solar radiation decreases from 1000W/m² to 200W/m², the power drops proportionally – from 300W to 60W.

The battery was showing 12.4 volts When I connected my volt-meter to the charge controller connections to the solar I got that same less than 9 volts. Whenever I connect the solar panel to the charge controller the voltage coming out of the charge controller would drop.

Voltage drop when using inverter

While in "Float" the charge controller watch for voltage drop, which would indicate a load. If the voltage begins to drop the charge controller will allow as much current to flow from the panels/array to compensate and maintain the voltage. If the voltage can be maintained, the load will in essence be running directly off the array/solar.

Why does solar voltage drop under load

I have a floating solar pump with panels putting out 30 volts and 360 watts. The meter shows 30 volts at the pump end but as soon as I connect the 24 volt pump it drops to 3 volts and obviously doesn't work.

Battery Voltage drop when running my 600w inverter

They should be a fine test. 70W should run for about 16 hours from a full charge if there is not excessive voltage drop. After a full charge, turn on the lights, no solar, wait about 5 minutes. Using a volt/multimeter, measure and record the voltage at the battery terminals and at the inverter battery terminals.

When I test the voltage from the panels on the line side of the fuses I get 72.9 volts for each panel. When I close the fuse completing the circuit to the charge controller and the batteries the voltage drops to 1.9 volts tested at the load side of the fuses and at the pv +/- terminals on the charge controller.

PV voltage drops ~60% when connected to charge ...

This is far more of a voltage drop than I would expect from two of these panels in series. The one-way distance from panels to charge controller is only 2 meters. This change in voltage is observed simply by removing one PV wire from the charge controller, marking 30Voc, then plugging the same cable into the charge controller, and marking 13.2V.

PV and battery voltage high, but battery drops ...

The problem started about a month ago - right around the time that the real dry season began. The PV voltage (as reported by the controller) runs to about 16v during the 8 hours of good sunlight and the battery voltage stays around 14v when there is no load connected. The controller reports that the battery is fully charged.

Rapid Voltage Drop Under Heavy Load... Normal?

I agree with Vic--Typical AGM charging voltage for ~75F, is (14.4 volts * 2 batteries =) 57.6 volts. When the battery charging current falls (below ~1% to 0.1% rate of charge -- i.e., 800 AH battery bank * 0.01 = 8 amps) or lower--Then they are usually fully charged. 54.2 volts / 4 = 13.55 volts--That is a typical range for float charging (after bulk/absorb charging has been completed).
